Come to the Jubilee!

"Wake up! Let's go to the Jubilee!"

I remember from childhood, the excitement surrounding the early morning event - when the beach along Mobile Bay was filled with fish and crabs and shrimp. People gathered on the beach, blowing horns and ringing bells in celebration. Men, women, and children dragged tubs and coolers to the waters' edge where they scooped up seafood to fill their freezers. Later in the day, neighbors met for shrimp and crab boils and fish fries to celebrate their harvest from the sea. It was a Jubilee - a naturally occurring vearly event where tide water conditions force sea creatures to the surface of the bay seeking

oxygen. In South Alabama, it was a time of joy and celebration – a time of plenty, when neighbors shared with neighbors and friends and strangers – and no one went home hungry.

Christians and Jews celebrate another kind of Jubilee- a Holy Year

The Jubilee is described in the Books of Joshua and Leviticus as a time of forgiveness of sins and pardon from wrongdoing. Every 50 years, slaves and prisoners were set free, debts were forgiven and God's joy and mercy were shown. The people of the Tribes of Israel returned to their homelands.



In recent Christian history, since 1300,

particularly in the Roman Church, Jubilees are celebrated every 25 to 50 years. They are known as years of great joy and and mercy. Many Christians make a pilgrimage to Rome to visit St. Peter's Basilica. The Golden Doors are opened for everyone to enter the Church and receive God's joy and forgiveness. What a feeling of joy and peace it was for me to walk through those Golden Doors in Rome during the Jubilee Year of 1975. I celebrated that Jubilee with my college classmates, studying in Italy.

This January 2019, with a group of Daughters of the King in Atlanta, I was present to celebrate another (off-year) Jubilee. In honor of God's joy, peace, forgiveness and mercy, the Province IV Board named our Province IV Assembly, "The Jubilee Chapter". We invite you to share in the celebration this year and share God's love in community with Daughters of the King around the Province.

He awaits us with open arms.



Serving as a missionary in the Dominican Republic 1965-1972 and 1985-1988 he then served in the Diocese of South Carolina 1972-1985 and 1988 until he became the Diocese's Bishop Suffragan in 1996. He resigned in 2006 and became Assistant Bishop in the Dominican Republic in 2008, serving there until his "second" retirement in 2012. He and his wife, Debbe, have 4 daughters and a plethora of grandchildren. They reside in North Charleston, South Carolina.

<u>The Use of Meditation and Journaling as Ways to Grow Closer to</u> God - The special Prayer Chapel, made by Daughters for Summer Kanuga, will be the location for this workshop. (a Gooch Hall Classroom) There will be a guided meditation and time given for journal writing/drawing to record participants' responses.

<u>The Labyrinth and Prayer</u> - Learn the history of the labyrinth and how using it can be an opportunity to encourage quietness and focus to enrich prayer life. Note: A special opportunity will be given for Senior Daughters to "pray the labyrinth" on Saturday night. Luminaries will be used to enhance this time of prayer.

<u>"Be Still and Know" Bracelets</u> - This craft workshop offers a time to make/take something that will be a reminder to stop and "be still" during our very busy lives. (Cost for this workshop will be \$5.00 or less.)
